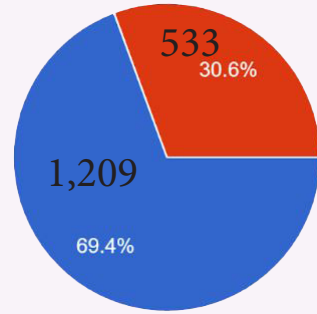

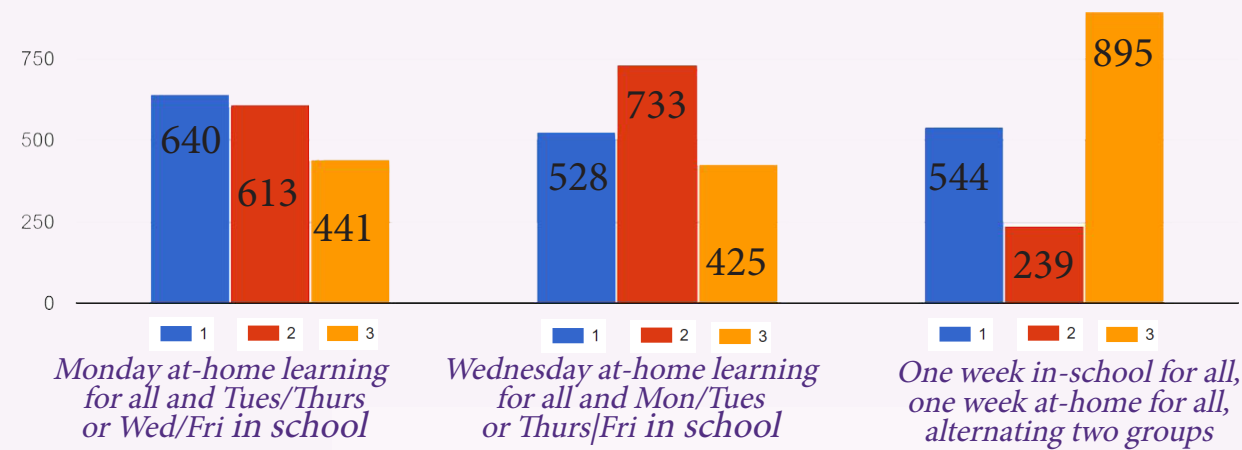
Preschool - **125** (7.1 %)

If conditions worsen, and the District is forced to abandon a normal school schedule which do you prefer?

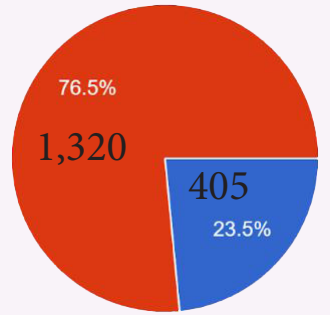
- Split/Alternating n-school and at-home schedule
- Strictly at-home learning



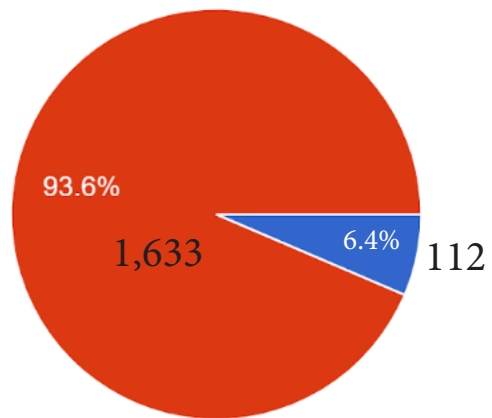
Rank 1 being most preferred, 3 least preferred:



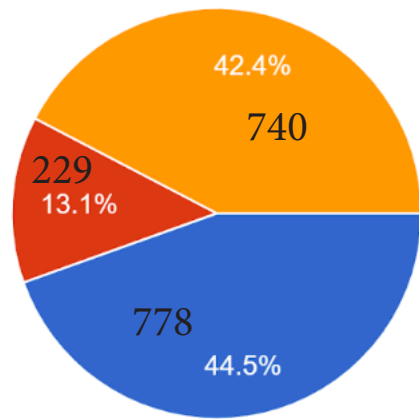
Which do you prefer your NOT physically attend school and receive a remote learning option?



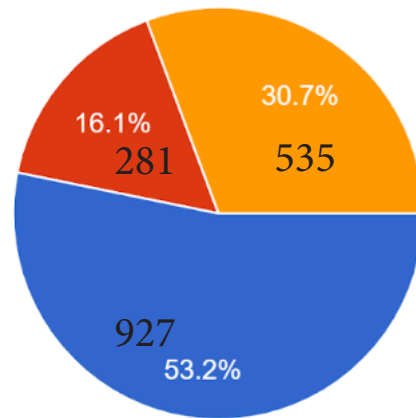
Do you have children w/health concerns which may prevent them from attending school?



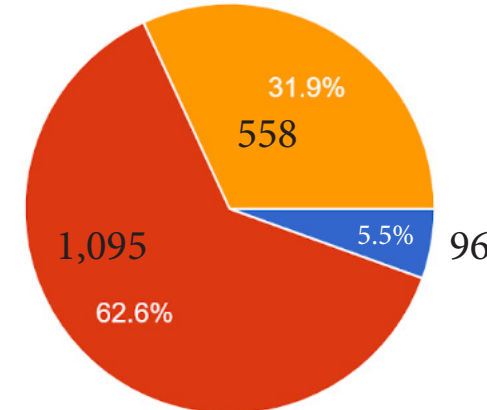
Will you send your PK-5 student to school if masks are NOT required?



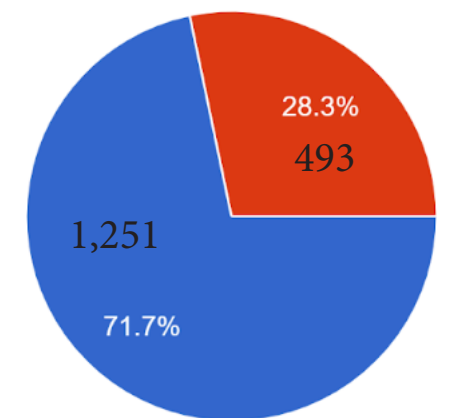
Will you send your 6-12 student to school if masks ARE required?



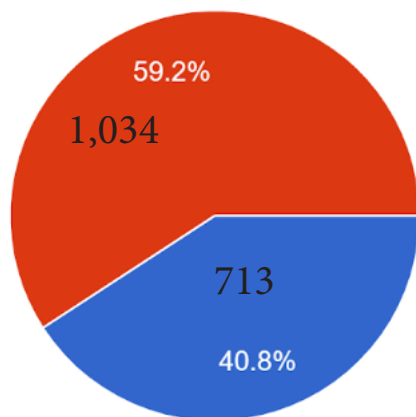
Does your 6-12 student have a health condition that will prevent wearing a mask?



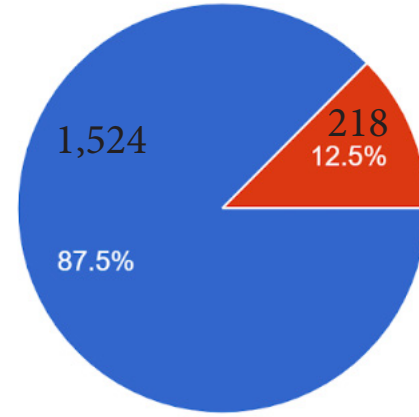
If ALL students are required to wear a mask, would you send your child to school?



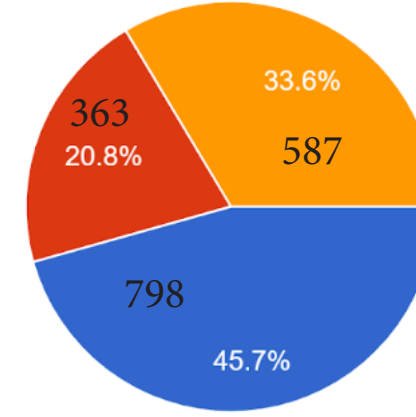
Are you concerned with your child physically returning to school?
